program, or a child or youth with whom a UAC may have contact (e.g., a classmate at school). †A non-UAC minor can include another child or youth residing at the same care provider facility, a participant in the Unaccompanied Refugee Minors (URM)

and adult on minor incidents. Prior to April 8, 2017, allegations of sexual abuse were referred to DOJ/EOUSA. If the allegation involved an adult, the allegation was referred to DOJ/EOUSA and the DOJ/FBI. After April 8, 2017, care providers directly reported all allegations of sexual abuse to DOJ/FBI, including both minor on minor
