- Immigrants pay **\$18.2 billion** annually in NY State income taxes. But over 1 million NYC residents can't vote on how that tax money is spent.
- Immigrants voted in all types of elections for the first 150 years of U.S. history.
- Immigrants currently vote in Chicago, parts of Maryland, and in 20 other democratic countries around the world. There are active campaigns to restore voting rights in California, Minnesota, Maine, Connecticut, and Washington, D.C.
